

**Title:** Impact Internship-ADPH, Men's Health

**Name of Agency:** Alabama Department of Public Health

**Location:** Montgomery, AL

**Project Description:**

The purpose of the project is to prepare a series of training modules regarding Men's Health to be used by ADPH staff as an educational tool in doing presentations for the public, regarding the causes of death in men in Alabama. One module will be about men's health in general, while two more will be developed on two of the top ten causes of death in men in Alabama, as designated by the State Health Officer. The scope of the work will include research on this topic, the development of power point presentations, and assistance in preparing a Men's Health event in June, 2012. Men's Health is a definite health disparity in Alabama due to lack of awareness, poor health education, and culturally induced behavior patterns in mens' work places and in their personal lives. Their health has great impact on their wives, daughters, sisters, and sons.
